## WELSHPOOL SALE REPORT

## **SATURDAY 10TH OCTOBER 2020**

The 2020 autumn sales procedure has of course looked slightly different to usual and with the cancellation of one of it's regular breed sales no doubt coming as a blow to members, the BWCS was grateful to the team at Welshpool Market for hosting us on 10th October. Due to government measures in place at the time, there was an understandable reduction in both the number of entries as well as attendees on the day, however the quality of the cattle did not disappoint and prices have remained buoyant as in previous years, due in no small part to the strong demand for British White breeding females members have seen of late.

At the sale, two well-grown bulling heifers from the Castleton herd -Castleton Wynne (R) and Castleton Damsel 3 - sold for 1200gns apiece to the Emily Estate (UK) Ltd in Somerset, have keenly supported Society sales to build their new herd since joining the Society in September 2018. The same buyer also picked up two younger maiden heifers, a pair of yearlings from the Templar herd both sired by the 2019 Three Counties Champion Woodbastwick Doublet -Templar Jools 177 (pictured below) for 900gns and Templar Jill 178 for 600gns.

The positions of BWCS President and Vice President are elected every two years. The Executive Committee is made up of 12 members, one third of whom retire in rotation at each Annual General Meeting and are eligible for re-election by the membership.

# WELSH BVD ERADICATION SCHEME EXTENDED

Following a successful reprofiling of the Gwaredu BVD Programme in Wales and a consultation with the agricultural industry, additional funding is now available to support both Young Stock Screenings and PI Hunting. As an industry-led initiative, the main objective to eradicate BVD from all cattle herds in Wales remains unchanged, with the extension allowing all stakeholders additional time to prepare for possible legislation changes in 2021.

Since launching in 2017, the Gwaredu BVD Programme has achieved highly successful results; with over 8,300 herds in Wales part of the programme as of July 2020. With additional financial support now available, Gwaredu BVD now urge both vets and farmers to take advantage whilst they can. Funding for Young Stock Screening has been extended from 31st August 2020 to the 31st March 2021, with financial support available to hunt PIs until the end of 2022.

With 78% of farms in Wales now free from BVD, additional funding will allow vets to conduct further testing - if needed - to protect this rate. This increased payment rate for fourth tests will apply retrospectively from April 27th, 2020. Any fourth tests conducted before the extension date

(September 1st, 2020) will be honoured and paid as part of the extended programme. Historically, every herd that tests positive for BVD is eligible for one additional PI Hunt funded up to the sum of £500 + VAT through the Gwaredu BVD programme.

Aligned with the Young Stock Screening extension, PI hunting financial support has also been extended and is available until the end of 2022. The programme will now offer additional funding up to the sum of £500 for PI hunting, taking the total available to £1000 + VAT. All additional funding for PI hunting is designed to be used specifically for sampling costs only.

The voluntary phase of testing for BVD in Wales ends on 31st March 2021.


