#### **BWCS LAUNCHES ANNUAL HERD SURVEY**

Beginning in 2019, members will be asked to participate in an annual herd survey, to be completed at the end of each year and requiring any member who has cattle registered under their name to update their BWCS herd record.

#### IT'S VERY SIMPLE!

With your copy of the December newsletter you will receive a list of cattle currently registered under your ownership. Just mark any deaths, castrates, young bulls requiring inspection or animals which have been sold.

#### **RETURNING YOUR SURVEY**

You can either post your paper copies to the Breed Secretary, scan and email them to admin@britishwhitecattle.co.uk, or update your herd record online by logging in to the Grassroots database using your Herd No. & Web Password which are listed in the top right-hand corner on page 1 of your herd survey.

#### WHY IT'S IMPORTANT

Keeping an accurate record of the live British White population is incredibly helpful in allowing the Society to track numbers of breeding animals, so please do make sure your herd record is kept up to date each year!

#### AND DON'T FORGET...

If there are any animals in your herd which are missing from the survey list, either because they haven't yet been registered or transferred into your name, please contact the Society straight away. To appear in the 2019 Herd Book, registrations must be submitted by **28**<sup>th</sup> **February 2020** and the longer you wait the more expensive it could be, so don't leave it to the last minute!
